

PUBLIC OFFER

for Making a Charitable Donation

dated April 28, 2026

This Public Offer for Making a Charitable Donation, hereinafter referred to as the **Offer**, is an official proposal of the **CHARITABLE ORGANIZATION CHARITABLE FOUNDATION GLOSSARY ECO FOUNDATION**, EDRPOU code **44592310**, hereinafter referred to as the **Foundation** or the **Organization**, represented by the President of the Foundation, **Viktoriia Yuriivna Ovcharova**, acting on the basis of the Charter, addressed to an indefinite number of individuals and legal entities who wish to voluntarily support the activities of the Foundation by making a charitable donation.

The Offer is published on the official website of the Foundation: <https://glossaryecofoundation.org/>, hereinafter referred to as the **Website**, and determines the procedure, terms, and legal consequences of making charitable donations in favour of the Foundation.

By making a charitable donation by any available method, the Donor confirms that he/she has read the terms of this Offer, fully understands its content, and unconditionally accepts its provisions.

This Offer serves as the basis for entering into a charitable donation agreement between the Foundation and the Donor in accordance with the provisions of the Civil Code of Ukraine, the Law of Ukraine “On Charitable Activities and Charitable Organizations,” and other applicable legislative acts of Ukraine. The legal framework of offer and acceptance in Ukraine is based, in particular, on the provisions of the Civil Code of Ukraine regarding an offer to enter into an agreement and its acceptance.

1. Definitions and Terms

1.1. Offer means this public proposal of the Foundation to enter into a charitable donation agreement on the terms defined herein, published on the Website and addressed to an unlimited number of persons.

1.2. Donor means an individual or legal entity, whether resident or non-resident of Ukraine, who voluntarily provides the Foundation with a charitable donation in monetary form or by another method permitted under the applicable legislation of Ukraine.

1.3. Foundation / Organization means the Charitable Organization “Charitable Foundation ‘GLOSSARY ECO FOUNDATION’,” a non-profit organization acting on the basis of its Charter and the applicable legislation of Ukraine.

1.4. Website means the official website of the Foundation located at: <https://glossaryecofoundation.org/>.

1.5. Acceptance of the Offer means the full, unconditional, and voluntary acceptance by the Donor of the terms of this Offer by making a charitable donation, including by bank transfer, through a payment form on the Website, via a payment service, or by any other available method.

1.6. Charitable Donation means the voluntary, gratuitous, and non-refundable transfer of monetary funds by the Donor into the ownership of the Foundation to support its statutory activities, charitable programs, environmental, educational, informational, awareness-raising, and other initiatives.

1.7. Charitable Donation Agreement means an agreement between the Foundation and the Donor, which is deemed concluded from the moment of Acceptance of this Offer.

2. Subject Matter of the Agreement

2.1. The subject matter of this Agreement is the voluntary transfer by the Donor of a charitable donation in favour of the Foundation to support and implement its statutory goals, programs, projects, and initiatives.

2.2. Charitable donations may be used by the Foundation, in particular, for:

- implementation of environmental, educational, awareness-raising, and informational projects;
- support of initiatives in the field of sustainable development, environmental culture, and responsible consumption;
- preparation, publication, and distribution of materials, research, articles, informational campaigns, and public materials;
- organization of events, programs, communication campaigns, partnership initiatives, and other activities of the Foundation;
- support of the administrative, organizational, technical, and operational activities of the Foundation within the limits permitted by the legislation of Ukraine;
- other areas that correspond to the Charter of the Foundation and the applicable legislation of Ukraine.

2.3. The amount of the charitable donation is determined independently by the Donor. The Foundation does not establish a mandatory minimum or maximum donation amount, unless otherwise expressly indicated on the Website or within a separate charitable campaign.

2.4. Making a charitable donation does not provide for the Donor to receive any profit, property benefit, goods, works, services, or any other counter-performance from the Foundation.

2.5. The charitable donation is made by the Donor voluntarily, without coercion, at the Donor's own discretion, and with an understanding of its charitable nature.

3. Acceptance of the Offer

3.1. Acceptance of this Offer shall be any action by the Donor aimed at transferring a charitable donation in favour of the Foundation.

3.2. From the moment of Acceptance, the Donor confirms that he/she:

- has read the terms of this Offer;
- understands the legal nature of a charitable donation;
- agrees that the transferred funds shall be used by the Foundation in accordance with its statutory activities;
- consents to the processing of personal data within the scope necessary for the performance of this Offer;
- agrees that part of the charitable donation may be used for the administrative expenses of the Foundation within the limits provided by the applicable legislation of Ukraine.

3.3. The charitable donation agreement between the Donor and the Foundation is deemed concluded from the moment the funds are credited to the Foundation's bank account or from the moment a successful payment is confirmed by the relevant payment system.

3.4. The Parties agree that entering into a separate written agreement is not mandatory if the Donor has accepted this Offer by making a charitable donation.

3.5. If the Donor does not agree with the terms of this Offer, he/she must refrain from making a charitable donation.

4. Rights and Obligations of the Foundation

4.1. The Foundation has the right to:

4.1.1. Receive charitable donations from Donors in the manner defined by this Offer.

4.1.2. Independently determine the specific areas of use of the donations received within the scope of the Foundation's statutory activities.

4.1.3. Allocate charitable donations to the implementation of current and future programs, projects, informational campaigns, environmental, educational, and awareness-raising initiatives.

4.1.4. Use part of the received donations to cover administrative, organizational, technical, banking, communication, and other expenses related to the activities of the Foundation, within the limits permitted by the applicable legislation of Ukraine.

4.1.5. Engage contractors, consultants, volunteers, partners, technical specialists, payment services, and other third parties to support the activities of the Foundation and achieve the purposes for which donations are raised.

4.1.6. Amend this Offer by publishing a new version on the Website.

4.1.7. Decide to terminate, modify, expand, or combine separate charitable programs or campaigns, provided that this does not contradict the Charter of the Foundation or the applicable legislation of Ukraine.

4.2. The Foundation shall:

4.2.1. Use the received charitable donations in accordance with the statutory activities of the Foundation and the applicable legislation of Ukraine.

4.2.2. Provide a technical or organizational possibility to make a charitable donation by available methods.

4.2.3. Keep records of the received charitable donations in accordance with the requirements of the legislation of Ukraine.

4.2.4. Not use charitable donations for purposes that contradict the legislation of Ukraine, the Charter of the Foundation, or the nature of charitable activities.

4.2.5. Ensure the protection of Donors' personal data within the limits provided by the applicable legislation of Ukraine.

4.2.6. Upon receipt of a relevant request from the Donor, provide information on the general areas of use of charitable donations, provided that such information is not confidential, internal, or otherwise restricted from disclosure under the legislation of Ukraine.

5. Rights and Obligations of the Donor

5.1. The Donor has the right to:

5.1.1. Independently determine the amount, method, and frequency of making a charitable donation.

5.1.2. Make a charitable donation by bank transfer, through a payment form on the Website, via a payment service, or by any other available method determined by the Foundation.

5.1.3. Contact the Foundation with a request for general information about the use of charitable donations.

5.1.4. Receive informational messages, news, reports, publications, and other materials about the activities of the Foundation if the Donor has provided the relevant contact details or subscribed to such communications.

5.1.5. Refuse to receive informational messages from the Foundation by contacting the Foundation or using another available unsubscribe mechanism, if such mechanism is provided.

5.1.6. In the case of a recurring payment, cancel it in accordance with the rules of the bank, payment system, or relevant service.

5.2. The Donor shall:

5.2.1. Read the terms of this Offer before making a donation.

5.2.2. Provide accurate information when making a payment or communicating with the Foundation.

5.2.3. Not use payment instruments belonging to third parties to make a donation without the proper authorization of such persons.

5.2.4. Independently bear responsibility for the correctness of payment details, payment purpose, donation amount, and other data required to make the transfer.

5.2.5. Not take any actions that may disrupt the operation of the Website, payment system, banking services, or otherwise interfere with the activities of the Foundation.

6. Place and Terms for Receiving Charitable Donations

6.1. Public collection of charitable donations is carried out through the Website, bank accounts of the Foundation, payment services, and other lawful instruments for raising charitable assistance.

6.2. Charitable donations may be made by Donors from Ukraine and other countries, provided that such donations do not contradict the legislation of Ukraine, the legislation of the Donor's country of residence, and the rules of the relevant banking or payment systems.

6.3. The direct place of activity of the Foundation is the location of the Organization specified in Section 14 of this Offer.

6.4. The collection of charitable donations continues throughout the term of the Foundation's activity, unless another term is determined by the Foundation for a separate program, campaign, or project.

6.5. The Foundation has the right to temporarily suspend or terminate the acceptance of charitable donations through certain payment instruments in the event of technical necessity, a change of payment provider, bank requirements, changes in legislation, or other objective reasons.

7. Procedure for Making a Charitable Donation

7.1. The Donor may make a charitable donation by one of the following methods:

- by bank transfer to the Foundation's account;
- through a payment form placed on the Website;
- through a payment service connected to the Website;
- by another method indicated by the Foundation on the Website or separately agreed with the Foundation.

7.2. The Foundation's bank details are specified in Section 14 of this Offer and/or on the relevant page of the Website.

7.3. The Donor independently selects the donation amount. If the payment form provides suggested amounts, such amounts are for informational purposes only and do not limit the Donor's right to choose another donation amount, where technically possible.

7.4. If the Website or payment service provides the option of a recurring donation, the Donor may choose a recurring payment. Cancellation of a recurring payment is carried out in accordance with the rules of the relevant bank, payment system, or service.

7.5. A payment is considered completed after confirmation of a successful transaction by the bank or payment system, or after the actual crediting of funds to the Foundation's account.

7.6. Fees of banks, payment systems, money transfer services, currency conversion costs, and other payments related to the transfer of the donation are paid in accordance with the rules of the relevant bank or payment service.

7.7. The Foundation shall not be liable for delays, errors, refusals, blocking, or other circumstances related to the operation of banks, payment systems, payment infrastructure operators, or other third parties.

7.8. A charitable donation is non-refundable and shall not be returned, except in cases where a refund is expressly provided for by the applicable legislation of Ukraine or where the transfer was made by mistake and the Foundation has recognized the existence of grounds for such refund.

8. Procedure for the Use of Charitable Donations

8.1. All charitable donations received by the Foundation are used for the implementation of the Foundation's statutory activities, its charitable programs, environmental, educational, informational, awareness-raising, and other initiatives.

8.2. The Foundation independently determines the procedure, timing, priority, and specific areas of use of the received charitable donations, unless the Donor has indicated a specific intended purpose of payment.

8.3. If the Donor has indicated a specific purpose for the donation, the Foundation shall make reasonable efforts to use the funds in accordance with such purpose, provided that it corresponds to the Charter of the Foundation, the applicable legislation of Ukraine, and the actual needs of the relevant program or project.

8.4. If the use of the donation for a specific purpose becomes impossible, impractical, excessively burdensome, or inconsistent with the current needs of the Foundation, the Foundation has the right to use such donation for other statutory purposes that are similar in nature to the original purpose or related to the general activities of the Foundation.

8.5. Charitable donations may be used both directly for project implementation and to cover related expenses necessary to support the Foundation's activities, including expenses for administration, communication, technical support, banking services, legal and accounting support, creation of materials, Website maintenance, and other needs.

8.6. The Donor may exercise control over the use of the charitable donation within the limits provided by the applicable legislation of Ukraine by submitting a relevant written request to the Foundation.

9. Liability of the Parties

9.1. The Parties shall be liable for non-performance or improper performance of their obligations under this Offer in accordance with the applicable legislation of Ukraine.

9.2. The Foundation shall not be liable for the inability to accept or process a charitable donation if such inability arose as a result of:

- technical failures in the operation of banks, payment systems, hosting providers, internet providers, or other third parties;
- incorrect payment details specified by the Donor;
- restrictions imposed by a bank or payment system;
- actions or omissions of third parties beyond the control of the Foundation;
- force majeure circumstances.

9.3. The Donor shall be responsible for the accuracy of the information provided to the Foundation, as well as for the lawful origin of the funds transferred as a charitable donation.

9.4. The Foundation is not obliged to verify the motives for making a charitable donation, unless otherwise required by the legislation of Ukraine, financial monitoring rules, banking procedures, or payment system requirements.

9.5. No provision of this Offer may be interpreted as a guarantee of achieving a specific result of any particular charitable program, project, campaign, or initiative.

10. Confidentiality and Personal Data Protection

10.1. By making a charitable donation, the Donor consents to the processing of personal data by the Foundation within the scope necessary to accept the donation, record payments, communicate with the Donor, prepare reports, and comply with the requirements of the legislation of Ukraine.

10.2. The Donor's personal data may include: first name, last name, patronymic, email address, telephone number, payment identifiers, information about the amount and date of payment, payment purpose, as well as other data voluntarily provided by the Donor to the Foundation.

10.3. The Foundation processes personal data in accordance with the Law of Ukraine "On Personal Data Protection" and other applicable legislative acts of Ukraine. This law regulates legal relations related to the protection and processing of personal data.

10.4. The Donor's personal data may be processed for the following purposes:

- acceptance and identification of the charitable donation;
- accounting, tax, and management record-keeping;
- preparation of the Foundation's reports;
- communication with the Donor;
- sending informational messages, news, reports, and materials about the activities of the Foundation;
- compliance with the requirements of the legislation of Ukraine;
- protection of the rights and legitimate interests of the Foundation.

10.5. The Foundation does not sell, transfer, or disclose Donors' personal data to third parties, except in cases where such transfer:

- is necessary to process the payment;
- is made to banks, payment systems, technical providers, or other persons involved in payment processing;
- is required by the applicable legislation of Ukraine;
- is necessary for accounting, tax, or legal support of the Foundation's activities;
- is carried out with the consent of the Donor.

10.6. The Foundation takes reasonable organizational and technical measures to protect Donors' personal data from unlawful access, loss, alteration, dissemination, or other unlawful processing.

10.7. The Donor has the right to contact the Foundation regarding the processing of his/her personal data, clarification of data, withdrawal of consent to receive informational messages, or the exercise of other rights provided by the legislation of Ukraine.

10.8. The Foundation shall not be liable for the disclosure of personal data if such disclosure occurred as a result of unlawful actions of third parties, technical failures beyond the control of the Foundation, or due to the fault of the Donor.

11. Term of the Offer. Procedure for Amendments and Supplements

11.1. This Offer enters into force from the moment of its publication on the Website and remains valid until it is withdrawn by the Foundation or until a new version of the Offer is published.

11.2. The Foundation has the right at any time to amend, supplement, or restate this Offer in a new version without prior approval from Donors.

11.3. Amendments to the Offer enter into force from the moment they are published on the Website, unless another effective date is expressly specified in the new version of the Offer.

11.4. The Donor is obliged to independently check the current version of the Offer before making a charitable donation.

11.5. Making a donation by the Donor after the Offer has been updated means that the Donor accepts the new version of the Offer.

11.6. The Foundation has the right to withdraw this Offer, restrict certain methods of making donations, or temporarily suspend the acceptance of donations through the Website in the event of technical, organizational, legal, or other necessity.

12. Dispute Resolution Procedure

12.1. All disputes, disagreements, or claims arising between the Foundation and the Donor in connection with this Offer or the making of a charitable donation shall be resolved by the Parties through negotiations.

12.2. The Donor may send an inquiry or claim to the Foundation at the email address specified on the Website or in Section 14 of this Offer.

12.3. The Foundation shall consider the Donor's inquiry within a reasonable period, taking into account the content of the inquiry, the scope of the required review, and the availability of documents necessary for its consideration.

12.4. If the Parties fail to reach an agreement through negotiations, the dispute shall be resolved in accordance with the applicable legislation of Ukraine.

12.5. This Offer, the Charitable Donation Agreement, and the legal relations between the Foundation and the Donor shall be governed by the legislation of Ukraine.

12.6. In all matters not regulated by this Offer, the Parties shall be guided by the applicable legislation of Ukraine.

13. Force Majeure

13.1. The Parties shall be released from liability for full or partial non-performance of obligations under this Offer if such non-performance resulted from force majeure circumstances that arose after Acceptance of the Offer and objectively made it impossible to perform the relevant obligations.

13.2. Force majeure circumstances may include, in particular: hostilities, armed aggression, occupation, terrorist acts, mass unrest, a state of emergency or martial law, fires, floods, earthquakes, other natural disasters, epidemics, pandemics, quarantine restrictions, strikes, decisions of public authorities, international sanctions, large-scale technical failures, interruptions in the operation of banking or payment systems, cyberattacks, and other events that the Parties could not foresee or prevent by reasonable measures.

13.3. The period for performing obligations affected by force majeure circumstances shall be extended for the duration of such circumstances and their consequences.

13.4. The Foundation has the right to notify Donors of the occurrence of force majeure circumstances by publishing relevant information on the Website or through other available communication channels.

13.5. The existence of force majeure circumstances does not release the Parties from the performance of obligations that do not depend on such circumstances or may be performed after such circumstances cease to exist.
